Eye bolt wood kit 151 piece. Screw eyes are a screw with a loop on one end and threads on the other end. Screw eyes are commonly used to attach cables to objects, for instance attaching a string to the back of a painting to allow the painting to hang from a nail on a wall. Long-shanked screw eyes are termed vine eyes and are used to attach support wires to wooden fence posts when growing soft fruit or grape vines, the plants then being tied to the wires.

Wire eye lags (also called screw thread eye bolts, eye screws, or turned-bent eye lags) have a wood screw thread for use in wood or lag anchors. Like wire eye bolts, wire eye lags are intended for light duty applications and should not be used for angular loads.
